

## JHL Civil wins big at Caulfield Racecourse

Caulfield Racecourse has awarded JHL Civil the contract to construct a Stormwater Reuse System including butt welding and the installation of 800 m of 315 mm diameter polyethylene pipeline.

The scope of works includes stormwater pits and pipework connecting to the Council drainage, supply and installation of a Gross Pollutant Trap, pumps, floats, fittings and controls and an underground storage system. This is in addition to the design and construction of pump controls, electrical works and a delivery pipeline from the pumpwell to the lake in the centre of the race course.

Construction has started and the project is due for completion prior to the Caulfield Cup Race Day. The system is expected to save 45 ML/a of drinking water and will aid in keeping the racecourse green.
